

Stjepan tour





In the 15th century, the Kosača family ruled the area of Hum (Herzegovina) and was one of the most powerful noble families in the Kingdom of Bosnia. There are assumptions that the family was named after the village of Kosač near the rivers Piva and Tara. The influence and power of Kosača can be seen during the time of the first Bosnian king Tyrtko 1.











Roman military camp **Gračine**

When the Romans quelled the resistance of belligerent Illyrians, Dalmatians, and Pannonians in 9 AD they started building roads, bridges, and fortresses. One of the smaller military camps which served as accommodation for one cohort of 400 soldiers and one hundred members of cavalry was located in Ljubuški. Most researchers assume that the camp was located on the site Gračine, four kilometers southwest from today's town center.

Archeological museum **Humac**

Archeological collection commonly known as Museum Humac is located within the Franciscan monastery Humac, Ljubuški.

Visit the oldest archeological Museum in Bosnia and Herzegovina located in a specific ambiance of the former old wine cellar. It holds artifacts from all over Herzegovina, which testify to time and culture from different historical periods. Within the monastery, there is also a themed permanent art gallery "Mother". There you can see an art collection with works from some of the greatest Croatian sculptors and painters of the 20th century.

Kravica Waterfalls

Through this area flows a unique river with nine names, full of travertine reliefs with stunning natural landscapes. It is a reserve of clean and clear water, magical waterfalls and diverse flora and fauna. The river Trebižat is 51 kilometers long and is the second largest submerged river in BiH, which springs and sinks several times in different locations. Among many natural rarities, the most important micro location is the Kravica waterfall with a water amphitheater over 120 meters long.

Experience the beauties of Ljubuški in a unique way – safari by Pinzgauer's off-road vehicles!

The adventurous journey begins in the most attractive place in Bosnia and Herzegovina – Kravice waterfalls, after which the journey continues to Butorovica hill and the medieval town of Ljubuški, followed by an old well called Vodice, Ljubuško polje (Plantaža), Trebižat river, and Austro-Hungarian bridge from the 19th century (Crvengorski). The journey through beautiful landscapes continues to Saint Anthony's monastery Humac along with the oldest museum in Bosnia and Herzegovina, and two churches from the 19th century.

Fortress of Herceg Stjepana Kosače

The late medieval fortress of the feudal ruler Duke Stjepan Kosača is the most monumental archeological site of the Ljubuški Municipality. It is located on a prominent top of a rocky chain of Butorovica hill (396 meters above the sea level). It serves as a symbol of Ljubuški, but also Herzegovina.

According to a legend this town arises from love. Hum ruler Stjepan rises the town for his mistress Ljubuša. Aside from the medieval complex of buildings, one can enjoy panoramic views of the fertile fields of the Ljubuški region, and the valley of Trebižat river.

Paragliding club **Ljubuški**


Gastro offers in Ljubuški
